## PAVING PLANNED

On Tuesday, July 26, Combs Construction Company, Inc., will begin installing asphalt pavement on Central Avenue between Western Avenue and Van Buren Street. Access will be maintained for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles; however expect traffic delays as the paving operation moves across driveways and side streets.

## INTERMITTENT SOUTHBOUND ROAD CLOSURES

**Central Avenue,  
Western Avenue to Van Buren Street  
7/26 to 7/29/16**

There is not enough room to maintain two-way traffic, construction equipment and personnel during paving activities. Therefore, expect intermittent southbound closures on Central Avenue between Western Avenue and Van Buren Street. The closures will take place Tuesday, July 26 through Friday, July 29. During this time, northbound Central Avenue will remain open. Commuters may use Litchfield Road, 5th Street and 4th Street as an alternate route. Access will be provided for residents, businesses, schools and emergency vehicles; however, allow extra time to travel through the construction zone as there may be traffic delays.

## ABOUT THE PROJECT

The planned enhancements will help create a user-friendly environment for vehicles, bicycles and pedestrians and will give this area of the community an inviting and functional purpose and appearance. The improvements include the installation of new asphalt pavement, curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveway entrances, landscape islands, storm drain pipe, catch basins and bus bays. When complete, Central Avenue will carry one lane of traffic in each direction with a center left turn lane and bike lanes.
